

**Distributed Print Repository
Outcome of Journal Title Assignments
March 2007**

Of the 28 libraries that completed the survey of holdings, 24 libraries were assigned the responsibility of holding titles for the distributed print repository:

If all 418 JSTOR and ACS titles were represented by 2 print runs, total *Holding Titles* would have been 836. As it stands, there are 55 titles where either no library held any print or where only one complete or partial run was available for the depository.

Criteria for Assembling Print Runs:

Three main principles were used in assembling the print runs:

Principle 1: Make the assembling of runs as easy and straightforward possible

- 100% with a current subscription
- 100% with no current subscription

- Large runs that could be completed by another library
- Partial runs
- Any material

Principle 2: Spread the wealth/responsibility around as much as possible

- Choose smaller libraries with complete runs whenever possible
- Alternate between libraries with largest holdings

Principle 3: Take something over nothing

- Take whatever is available for the depository, even if a full run is not present
